- 3. If a student **does not attend** post-secondary schools for **ANY REASON**, they will **forfeit** the remainder of the scholarship. If eligible, the student MUST resubmit an application for the following year. Applications will NOT be held over to the next year.
- 4. The recipient must be **currently enrolled or planning to enroll in a full-time course of undergraduate study** at an institution of higher learning, including a vocational/technical school, or two-year or four-year college or university.
- 5. The recipient must have a **cumulative grade point average** of **2.5 or higher**.
- 6. The Schwab Scholarship Committee will select recipients & scholarship amounts.
- 7. The quality and appearance of the application will be taken into consideration.
- 8. All students must complete the <u>entire application</u> and provide a <u>complete official</u> transcript and <u>three current</u> <u>letters of recommendation</u>. All documents must be postmarked no later than March 1, 2026 or your <u>application will not be considered</u>. It is the student's responsibility to ensure the entire application, including transcripts and recommendation letters, is received. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS.
