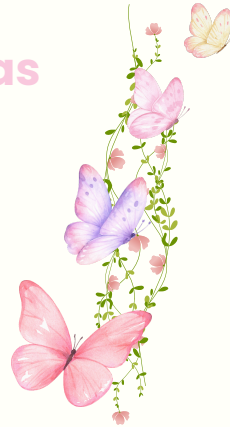

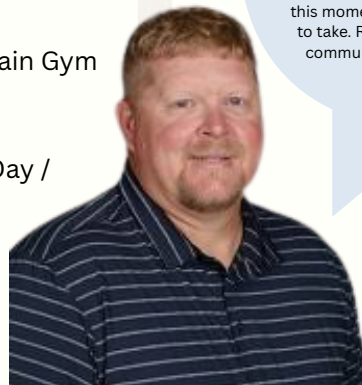

Interesting World Easter Traditions

In Norway: People read crime stories. This tradition, known as påskekrim, involves people becoming obsessed with tales of murder, mystery, and detectives during the Easter season.

In a village in France: They prepare a giant omelet right in the street using thousands of eggs, which is then shared among the entire community.

In Germany: They decorate trees with colorful eggs (known as "Easter trees"), creating a scene that resembles Christmas—but in the spring.

In Finland: Children dress up in costumes and go door-to-door asking for treats, much like on Halloween. People also light bonfires to "scare away evil spirits."

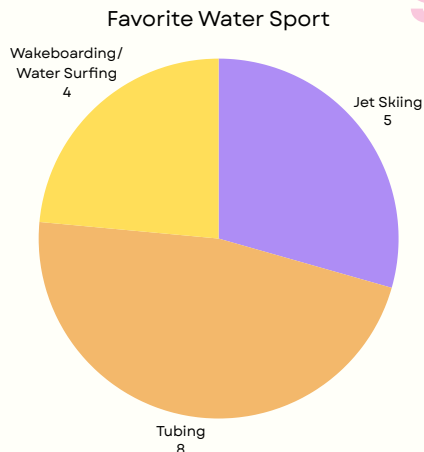

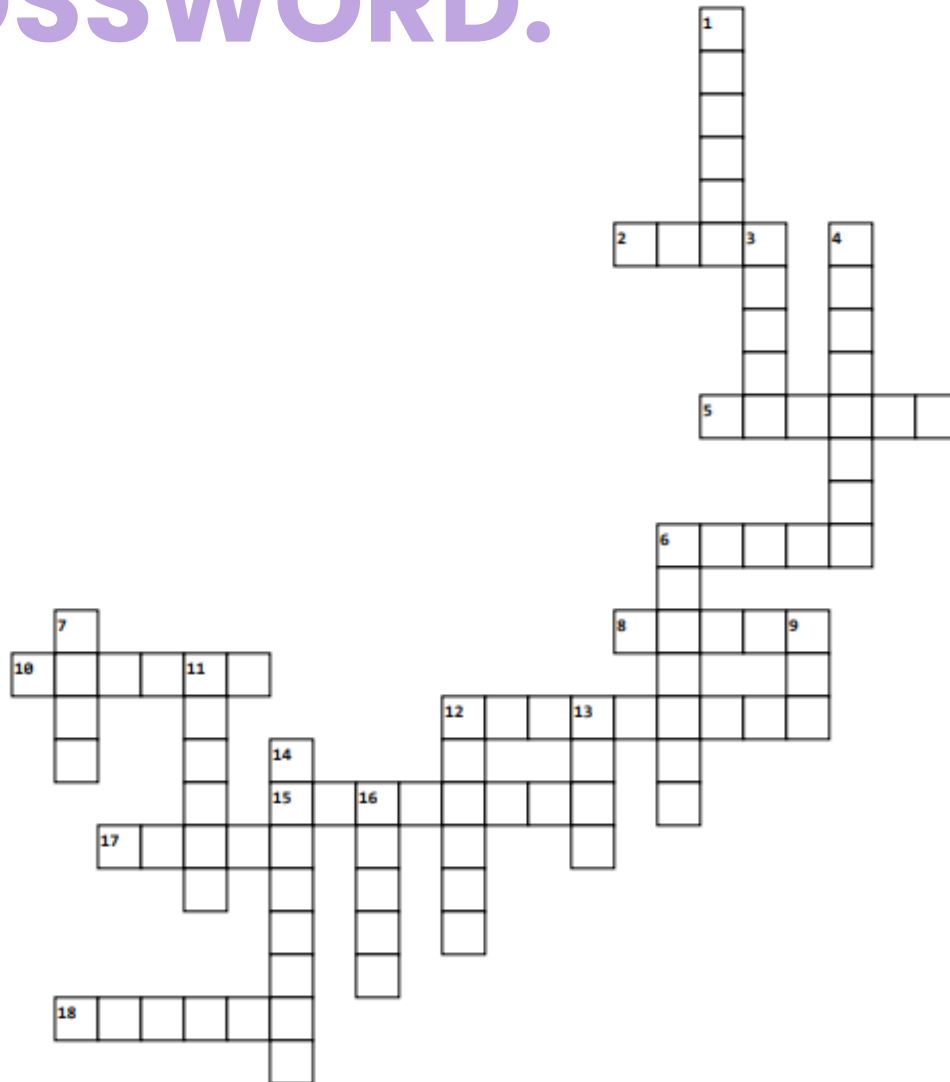

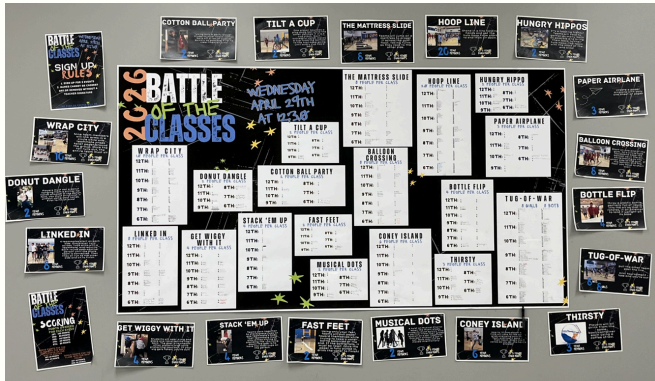
Senior Spotlight
